To be Eligible, You Must:

Be entering the 12th grade in a NYC public high school in September 2006
Have a GPA of 75% or higher
Show evidence of a strong interest in Maritime Technology by submitting an essay explaining why you want to enroll in the program.
Be committed to spending four days a week from 9:00 - 4:15 pm at Kingsborough from July 1st through July 31.
Be prepared to go outdoors in all types of weather and provide your own waterproof footwear and outerwear, and notebook and pens
Submit an application, copy of high school transcript and signed parental trip consent form by Friday, June 6.
